Stroll along with friends and loved ones or ride in your choice of horse drawn Vis-à-vis or Cinderella carriage at a nominal \$5 or \$10 per person cost to enjoy the entire **self-guided programmed tour**. Programs will be available at the hosting businesses and of course at the Dragonfly Gallery”, said Jerry as he exuded good will with an early case of over abundant Christmas spirit.

Along the candle lit tour path, stop by and visit the businesses hosting many talented local artists and their beautiful creations in their mediums of their choice. This is your time to meet the artist behind the original works of art! Don’t miss a specially scheduled book signing at Polka-Dots with children’s book author, Leah Webb. Make sure you take the entire tour to experience performances by the Santa Rosa Pipes and Drums (bagpipes!), barbershop quartets, caroling Civil War re-enactors in period costumes, specialty performances and many different caroler vignettes that have been scheduled throughout the downtown area for your enjoyment.

The Historic Downtown Milton will be lit in candle light along with the lamp poles wrapped in garland and festive lights! Be dazzled by the talent of Santa Rosa County and let us add to your wonderful Christmas experience with a bit of old fashion Christmas! Be sure to visit the special exhibit room set aside for “A Dragonfly Holiday”! The Dragonfly Gallery is a mission of the Santa Rosa Arts and Culture Foundation created to vitalize, promote and enrich the arts and culture in Santa Rosa County.
