5:30 PM to 7:00 PM

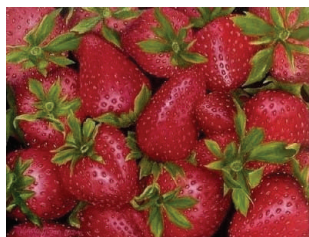

Beverages are available for purchase on site.

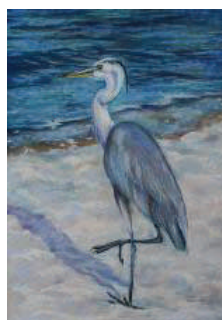


Oils & Acrylics "Masters' Technique" Open to All Levels

Classes are available by appointment only.

Australian Artist *Melinda Giron* will teach some of her most advanced techniques emulating the works of famous oil painting masters. These classes are designed for either beginners or as a refresher in technique for more advanced students. Students are encouraged to bring a lunch since class continues into the afternoon.
