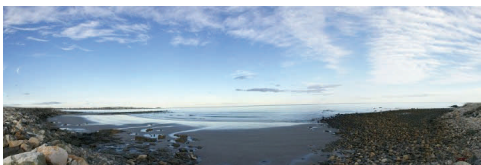


Santa Rosa Art Association Members Show

Introduction to Panoramic Photography

Also covered will be suggestions for printing and mounting.
